### Blockade of the 400 Highways

Early support for the blockade has been overwhelming. Plans are for local farmers and other interested groups to join the Lanark Landowners Association (LLA) in blockades of the 400 highways. The blockades will start on January 21, 2005 at the 401's Culloden Road cutoff near Ingersoll. The blockade will start at 6.30 AM and conclude at 4.30 PM.

Anyone involved in a rural issue has been asked to come and show support. It is time to let the government know that there is a serious crisis taking place in rural areas.

At this time more than 1,000 tractors have registered to be part of the blockade and an additional 500 are expected to register before Friday. Several buss loads of people from across the province are expected to arrive to show their support.

The Red Casket Relay from Kawartha Lakes will be on hand with the liberal red casket and 6 pallbearers along with the sign “McGuinty Lies Here”. Several committees representing de-amalgamation interests and communities will be part of the rally. A de-amalgamation stage will be part of the blockade with guest speakers in the morning and a presentation from the ODM (Ontario De-amalgamation Network) in the afternoon.

Hamilton will be well represented at the blockade with members from the Committee to Free Flamborough and several citizens representing Flamborough, Ancaster and Dundas. It is time that Mr. McMeekin and Mr. McGuinty lived up to their promise and arranged a binding referendum on the issue of de-amalgamation for all the people in Mr. McMeekin's riding.

The blockades will continue until such time as the will of the people becomes the basis for the authority of government.
