The Committee to Free Flamborough is pleased to announce that they will join with VOCO (Kawartha Lakes) in a march on Queens Park on March 24, 2004

A busload of VOCO supporters will be arriving in Toronto followed by a truck carrying a coffin. They will demonstrate by holding a peaceful funeral for democracy.

Democracy was buried by the Provincial Conservatives lead by Mike Harris and his Minister, Tony Clement. The new Liberal Party lead by Dalton McGuinty have found themselves in a position to fix this injustice and have chosen not to, so they inherit responsibility for that injustice and must be held accountable.

Kawartha Lakes has recently been delivered a “no, not now” verdict by the Provincial Liberal Government in response to their Democratically and Provincially run referendum. This referendum was approved for placement on the ballot but the Liberals say it is not binding. Shock waves have reverberated across the Province and the amalgamated communities are now joining forces to reclaim democracy.

There are more than 15,000 petitions from various areas waiting to be delivered to the house. The total of the petitions now signed represent more than 1.6 million voters. This cannot be ignored.
